


He has designed and constructed all the models we have the pleasure of presenting in this pamphlet.

... Not only violins are exhibited at this exclusive Exhibition. There is another branch of instrument building to be found: the art of building a good guitar... One of those who have contributed here is the manager of the Musical department of the Philadelphia Publishing House, Mr. Egon Zandelin. His name will from now on be mentioned with respect in the circles of guitar builders as he was awarded a gold medal and highest merits for quality, i. e. 90 marks out of 90 possible marks at the Exhibition for his exquisite Spanish guitar model and its brilliant tone.

At an interview Mr. Zandelin tells about his success guitar... The first one to see the results of my effort to build a first-class guitar was Mr. B. A. Heimer of the Violin Builders' Association of Sweden. He stepped into the Musical department of the Philadelphia Publishing House as I was about to string the gem. He was delighted at the result, and already then he expressed himself favourably about the instrument concerned. When later on the great Segovia visited our city and had a concert, I took the liberty of asking him to examine and test my instrument. He was so interested in it that he wrote his name on the sound-board of the guitar.»
