ELECTRIC MODELS

These superb instruments, so popular with many leading American players, delight guitarists everywhere with their outstanding quality of tone, craftsmanship and finish.

Body of flamed maple with purfled edges, hand-carved alpine spruce belly. Curved rosewood fingerboard and adjustable mahogany neck; every Levin guitar neck is fitted with a special duralumin rod to reinforce and facilitate easy adjustment should this prove necessary, the adjusting nut for this duralumin rod is to be found under the head-piece plate. Adjustable bridge, good quality single unit machine heads and tailpiece, both chromium plated and polished. The famous American-made 'De Armond' pick-up units are fitted, complete with screened lead and jackplugs.

MODEL 1898

Fitted with two 'De Armond' pick-up units, each with separate volume and tone controls and three-position selector switch.

MODEL 1897

Fitted with single 'De Armond' pick-up unit, separate volume and tone controls.

ACOUSTIC MODEL

MODEL 1797

Belly of hand-carved alpine spruce, body of flamed maple with purfled edges. Rosewood fingerboard and adjustable mahogany neck with motherof-pearl position dots. Good quality single unit machine heads, all metal parts nickel-plated.

(Similar in size and appearance to model 1898 above, but without pickup units.)

SUPER GOLIATH MODEL 1855

A large exceptionally attractive instrument of beautiful tone with steel strings and fixed ebony bridge. Body of flamed maple, belly of natural alpine spruce. Reinforced and adjustable neck; ebony fingerboard with off-set inlaid position markers; individual covered machine heads with all-metal buttons. Purfling around fingerboard and body, inlaid soundhole.

GOLIATH MODEL 1795

Similar in size and shape to model 1855 but with a darker, shaded finish body. Steel strings and fixed rosewood bridge. Belly of selected alpine spruce, body of figured maple. Rosewood fingerboard with off-set inlaid position dots and adjustable neck; individual covered machine heads with all-metal buttons. Purfling around fingerboard and body, inlaid soundhole.

GOLIATH ELECTRIC MODEL 1890

As model 1795 but fitted with American-made 'De Armond' pick-up unit, separate volume and tone controls.

GOLIATH 12-STRING MODEL 1844

Similarin size and styling to models 1795 and 1855. Body of flamed maple and belly of alpine spruce, both in natural wood colouring with inlaid edges and soundhole. Mahogany reinforced and adjustable neck; rosewood fingerboard with purfled edges and inlaid position dots. Best quality nickel-plated machine heads; fixed rosewood bridge and steel strings.

1740 Fully shaped plywood frame, rexine covered and felt lined.

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MODEL 1805

Levin's finest classic guitar. Top of specially selected alpine spruce, sides and back of beautiful flamed mountain maple, spliced mahogany neck, ebony fingerboard. Rosewood bridge, multicoloured mosaic around soundhole and outer edges of rosewood. Highly polished finish throughout. Nickel-plated single machine heads with bone rollers.

MODEL 1821

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Grand concert-size model. Selected alpine spruce top with flamed maple back and sides. Rosewood fingerboard, head and bridge. Inlaid soundhole, purfled edges to back and front. Good quality nickel-plated machine heads with bone rollers.

MODEL 1799

Concert model with alpine spruce belly, body of finest mahogany. Multi-coloured inlays around soundhole, white purfled edges back and front. Neck of mahogany with rosewood fingerboard and bridge. Good quality nickel-plated machine heads with large bone barrels.


MODEL 1794

Concert-size guitar with selected spruce belly, pure Swedish birch body. Rosewood fingerboard and bridge, purfled edge to belly and multi-coloured inlaid soundhole. Entire instrument highly polished and hand finished. Superior quality machine heads with bone rollers.
